Introduction

Verant Identification Systems, Inc. (“**Company**” or “**We**”) respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy. This policy describes:

- How software developed and/or maintained by Company through Apple Wallet (the “**App**”) functions and how your information is protected when you access, or use software.
- Our practices for not collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing your information.

This policy applies only to information we collect in this App.

This policy DOES NOT apply to information that:

- We may collect offline or on any other Company apps or websites, including websites you may access through this App.
- You provide to or is collected by any third party, including other apps, websites, or content that may link to or be accessible from or through this App (see Third-Party Information Collection), including, but not limited to Apple Wallet.

Our websites and apps, and these other third parties may have their own privacy policies, which we encourage you to read before providing information on or through them.

Please read this policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, do not use this App. By using this App, you agree to this privacy policy. This policy may change from time to time (see Changes to Our Privacy Policy). Your continued use of this App after we revise this policy means you accept those changes, so please check the policy periodically for updates.

About Us and How Our Software Interacts with Your Information

We are a provider of software solutions offering real-time verification of driver’s license data against official DMV records in seconds, as well as artificial intelligence powered comparison of a live photo and a driver’s license image to determine if it is the same person.

Our software does not store any driver’s license data or images, DMV records, live photos, or any personal information.

Our customers include financial institutions, automotive dealerships, and other businesses. These customers are third parties that may have their own privacy policies.

In certain cases, we may interact with data subjects for technical support purposes only, but even in those cases, we do not collect, share, or otherwise disclose any personal information with third parties.

We do not control third parties’ collection or use of your information to serve interest-based advertising. However, these third parties may provide you with ways to choose not to have your information collected or used in this way. You can opt out of receiving targeted ads from members of the Network Advertising Initiative (“**NAI**”) on the NAI’s website.

Your State Privacy Rights
